Future of Healthcare in Reeves County Takes Shape

Reeves County Hospital District celebrates the topping off a new hospital campus.

PECOS, Texas (Sept. 25, 2020) – The last beam has been lifted into place as Reeves County Hospital District celebrated a new phase of construction of a new hospital campus.

RCHD recently celebrated a topping off ceremony for the building that will soon be home to the region's newest healthcare facility.

"We are thrilled to see our new hospital begin to take shape," said Brenda McKinney, CEO of Reeves County Hospital District. "Construction is moving along, and we can't wait to begin seeing patients at the new facility next year."

RCHD staff gathered at the construction site on Pigman Avenue in Pecos to join the celebration as construction crews installed the last beam, marking a point when construction enters a new phase.

Reeves County Hospital District (RCHD) has worked with architects and a planning firm on final site plans, building renderings, and construction schedule. In January, construction crews began work on the building site. The new hospital campus is expected to open its doors in late 2021.

The RCHD Board of Directors voted in June 2018 to begin work on a new hospital campus to replace the current 88,000-square-foot facility that opened in 1978.

Plans for the new hospital campus call for more than 140,000 square feet of space to house general facilities with 25-beds, expanded space for core services including a larger emergency department, and upgraded technology. The new campus will also be in better compliance with requirements for disabled patients and visitors.

"This new hospital campus will ensure that healthcare continues to grow with the community," McKinney said. "Meeting our neighbors needs and protecting the health of our community is our promise."
