National Doctors' Day was first celebrated on March 30, 1933, in recognition of Dr. Crawford W. Long's pioneering use of anesthesia in 1842. In 1990, President George H.W. Bush officially designated March 30 as National Doctors' Day.

"In rural Texas, having dedicated doctors is not just a luxury but a lifeline," said **Brenda McKinney, CEO** of RRH. "National Doctors' Day is a powerful reminder of the incredible commitment shown by our local physicians who provide essential care to our community, often overcoming significant challenges to do so."

 (Must bring child's immunization card, insurance cards, with parent/guardian)
