- **Foot Screenings** by our healthcare team

- **Medication Disposal** – safely dispose of expired medications and used syringes

Available Screenings

Take advantage of low-cost screenings designed to help you stay informed about your health:

- **Complete Blood Package** – Fasting for 8 hrs. required – \$40 (available 8–11 a.m.)
- **PSA (Prostate-Specific Antigen) Test** – \$25 (available 8–11 a.m.)
- **EKG (Electrocardiogram)** – \$10

Screenings available **8 a.m. – 1 p.m.**

- **25 Free Mammograms** (must be over 40 years old, not experiencing any current symptoms such as lumps, pain or unusual changes, and 12 months since last mammogram)
