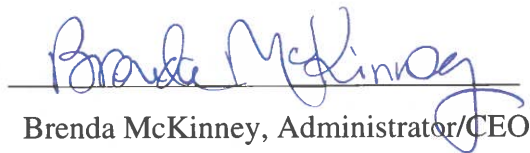

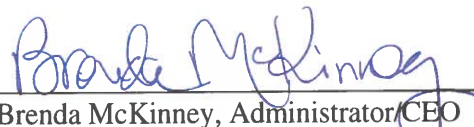

| Section 161.032 | To receive to receive records, information, or reports provided by a medical committee, medical peer review committee, or compliance officer. |

Should any final action, final decision, or final vote be required in the opinion of the Board with regard to any matter considered in such Closed or Executive Meeting or Session, then such final action, final decision or final vote shall be at either:

- (a) The Opening Meeting covered by this notice upon the reconvening of this public meeting, or;
